Re: *Geddry Dog Shooting (Case Nos. MCSO 1-02-002158 and AC060102-01)*

Dear Mr. Vroman:

Thank you for your letter of July 1, 2002. In your letter, you stated that you would discuss the case once the investigation was completed. You also stated that you would then decide what charges should be brought against the various Iversen family members.

Today, July 10, 2002, Special Investigator Cheryl Schussler informed me that the investigation is complete and all materials have been forwarded to you and/or Mr. Sawicki. Please inform me immediately of the charges that you intend to bring.

Also, I hereby renew my request for all information in your possession concerning these matters, including all paper and electronic files. Although you attempted to avoid service of process, a valid civil subpoena has been served on you after the process server located you in open court. You have indicated you intend to disobey that order served upon you. Please confirm whether this is still your intention.

In particular, we are concerned about Deputy District Attorney Mark Kalina's conversation with Sheriff's Deputy Bushnell on June 1, 2002 and Mr. Kalina's direct intervention and later visit to Mr. Bushnell for the purpose of having a "public nuisance" claim brought against Ms. Geddry. As you are aware, Mr. Bushnell somehow overlooked logging his conversation with Mr. Kalina on June 1, 2002 into the police report. Mr. Kalina has personal involvement in this matter and is engaged in a boundary dispute with Ms. Geddry. Mr. Kalina has improperly and illegally utilized his role to influence law enforcement.

Finally, on June 3, 2002 you telephoned Mendocino County Animal Control and informed them that the Geddry-Iversen dog matter “had been taken care of” and instructing them *not to investigate the matter*. On what basis and authority did you make this statement before the investigation was complete?
